## LEARNING OPTIONS FOR FAMILIES



### **IN-PERSON LEARNING AT SCHOOL**

Dependent upon health restrictions and guidance from KDHE and local health departments



### **Remote Learning**

Students will access learning 100% away from the school building. Students will have daily engagement with a USD 262 teacher.

## A SAFE ENVIRONMENT AT SCHOOL



### **SCHEDULE**

Depending upon the status of COVID-19 cases in Sedgwick County, in person learning may have: all students attending; be a hybrid model where students alternate days learning at school and days learning remotely; or all students learning remotely.



### **FACE COVERINGS**

While on district property, all students, staff, and visitors are required to cover their mouth and nose with a mask or similar face covering at all times with minimal exceptions. Mask breaks will be provided.



### **SOCIAL DISTANCING**

Social distancing guidelines will be followed. The number of people in shared spaces will be limited when feasible. Attempts will be made to distance desks and assigned seating will be used for contact tracing. Interaction between student cohorts will be limited.



### **HYGIENE MEASURES**

All people are required to wash and sanitize their hands when arriving at school and every hour. All will have their temperatures checked before entering any attendance center the first time each day.. Enhanced building cleaning and disinfecting practices will be followed.

## **WE NEED YOUR HELP!**

### **Students who are sick *MUST* stay home.**

Parents are expected to monitor their student(s) and keep them home if they or person the students have had contact with exhibits any symptoms of Covid-19. Students will be sent home if they come to school while sick. Please make sure the school has correct contact information.

## **PLANNING AHEAD**

We are prepared to shift to a remote only or fully in person learning model if recommended by the local health department. In the event of a local outbreak, classrooms or entire schools may be dismissed for remote learning for a period of time.
